### **ELIGIBILITY**

- Full-time students who are independent members or who are affiliated with educational institutions that are current members of OPERA America. Applicants may be undergraduates who have completed their junior or senior years of study at the time of the conference, or graduate students.
- Students must be engaged in the study of arts administration and demonstrate an interest in pursuing a professional career in the opera (or a closely related) field.
- Students must commit to attend all three days of the conference on June 10 through June 12.

### **DEADLINE and NOTIFICATION**

- The completed application must be received electronically by April 2, 2010.
- Awardees will be notified by April 16, 2010.

### **HOW TO APPLY**

Applications must include the following, submitted together in one package:

- Completed, signed application (page two of this document)
- A resume or bio (one page) outlining the field of study and any related internships or professional experience.
- A brief narrative (maximum of 150 words) describing applicant's interest in attending *Opera Conference 2010*.

\*\* Please keep in mind that while the conference is designed to be a networking opportunity for individuals working in the opera industry, it is not a vehicle for securing a job or scheduling an audition.
