The Robert L.B. Tobin Director-Designer Prize is a biennial program offered as part of OPERA America's continuing effort to foster emerging opera artists. The program is intended to bring new talent to the forefront and connect directors and designers early in their careers with those who are in a position to advance their work. Designer- or director-driven teams must select a work that is deeply resonant with the team from an OPERA America-approved list of operatic works. Original submissions will translate the team's meaningful response into a unique concept and design for the selected work. Four teams will be invited to turn speculative ideas into a full design presentation at Opera Conference 2023 in Pittsburgh, PA.

The Creative Team
