The first all-women spacewalk took place in October 2019. It was the 221st spacewalk performed in support of space station assembly. Although the milestone came far too late in NASA's history, it also signaled the advent of a new, more inclusive era for the agency. This story is compelling both for its description of women's remarkable scientific achievements and its broader social significance. This story celebrates our common humanity and inspires women, girls, and anyone committed to a more equitable world.
Within the opera, Spacewalk captures the wonder during the event and the sense of possibility it has since inspired. The work intersperses the real-time radio conversations of astronauts Christina Koch and Jessica Meir with Mission Control CAPCOM Stephanie Wilson talking during their spacewalk, with scenes of other female astronauts "in studio" explaining the difficulties, dangers, and delights of their assignment. These exchanges between actors and forebears provide crucial technical insight into the unfolding drama to the audience and heighten their contemplation and emotive response.
