This rubric will be used by OPERA America staff and field leaders to evaluate the written application and interviews.

SELECTION CRITERIA	CANDIDATE QUALITIES:
Field Knowledge	<ul> <li>Candidates will have:</li> <li>A preliminary understanding of field priority issues;</li> <li>A clear vision for how they will contribute significantly to the field;</li> <li>A genuine interest in making positive contributions by initiating change on a personal, departmental, or organizational level; and</li> </ul>
Leadership	Identified opportunities to develop their own learning toward those ends.  Candidates will:
Ecadersinp	<ul> <li>Have taken initiative to solve problems;</li> <li>Name specific accomplishments in at least one administrative area;</li> <li>Offer engaging/achievable/applicable/creative ideas/attitude/energy that serves them in relationship building; and</li> <li>Have an endorsement that reinforces these qualities and speaks to</li> </ul>
	their skills/accomplishments.
Clearly Articulated Goals	<ul> <li>Candidates will:</li> <li>Possess a strong dedication to the arts with long-term goals for achieving a dynamic role in the field;</li> <li>Outline clear objectives for professional growth in the short term that align with the learning and growth enabled by a mentor/mentee relationship; and</li> <li>Make the case that this program is best suited to their learning objectives, as opposed to other OPERA America offerings or academic programs.</li> </ul>
Career Stage	<ul> <li>Candidates will:</li> <li>Demonstrate an awareness of the challenges to achieving their goals, systemic and otherwise; and</li> <li>Articulate their desire to grow professionally and personally by participating in the program at this point in time and at this phase of their career.</li> </ul>
Field Civic Practice	<ul> <li>Candidates will offer evidence of interest in and/or attempts toward:</li> <li>Being mentored by, or mentoring, others in the field;</li> <li>Strengthening collegial connections among colleagues; and</li> <li>Participating in OPERA America network forums, listserv discussions, or other field learning activities.</li> </ul>
